

## TE ARAWA 500 Scholarship

### SCHOLARSHIP INCLUDES:

- \$1000 per year for the tenure<sup>1</sup> of the scholarship
- a weekend Te Arawa Wānanga to be held from Saturday 18 April, 10.00am to Sunday 19 April 2020, 12.00pm in Rotorua<sup>2</sup>
- mentoring support
- job placement assistance

### ELIGIBILITY:

- Te Arawa descendant who is registered OR who agrees to be registered as a beneficiary with Te Arawa Fisheries
- Full-time undergraduate or postgraduate student
- Enrolled at a University, Polytechnic, Wānanga or College of Education accredited by NZQA (or equivalent overseas institution)

### DOCUMENTATION:

- Must be complete, correct, timely and relevant otherwise application may not be considered<sup>3</sup>
- Application must be completed and submitted online via our website at [www.tearawafisheries.maori.nz](http://www.tearawafisheries.maori.nz) by the closing date of Friday 06 March 2020, 4.00pm.
- Declaration form must be signed and posted, couriered or hand delivered to be received by the closing date together with:
  - Deposit slip verified by the bank or bank statement
  - Certified copies of most recent and relevant academic record. If the applicant does not have any academic history, details of work/life experience should be attached instead
  - Certified copy of full-time enrolment confirmation that lists programme of study, courses/papers and course/paper costs
  - Certified copy of proof of payment of fees for programme/course costs

### CERTIFIED COPY:

A copy of an original document that has been endorsed by a person who certifies that the copy is a true copy of the original. The person who certifies the copy must be a Justice of the peace or a lawyer. Their signature is also required along with their name and title shown eligibly below their signature.

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<sup>1</sup> Tenure – The time agreed to complete the degree/s approved.

<sup>2</sup> A limited number of travel subsidies will be available for applicants travelling significant distances.

The second instalment will be paid upon receipt of a certified copy of first semester results.

- Failure to provide accurate information
- Failure to pass all papers towards the course approved
- Failure to complete prescribed course for the year
- Failure to provide required documentation as requested
- Non attendance at annual Wānanga
- Change of course of study without approval
- Unbecoming conduct
